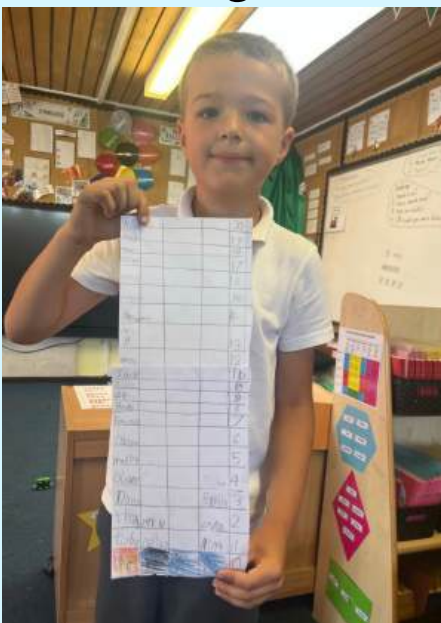
In Cymraeg, we have been learning about different foods. We did a fun taste test where the children had to guess what food or drink they were eating, answering in Welsh.

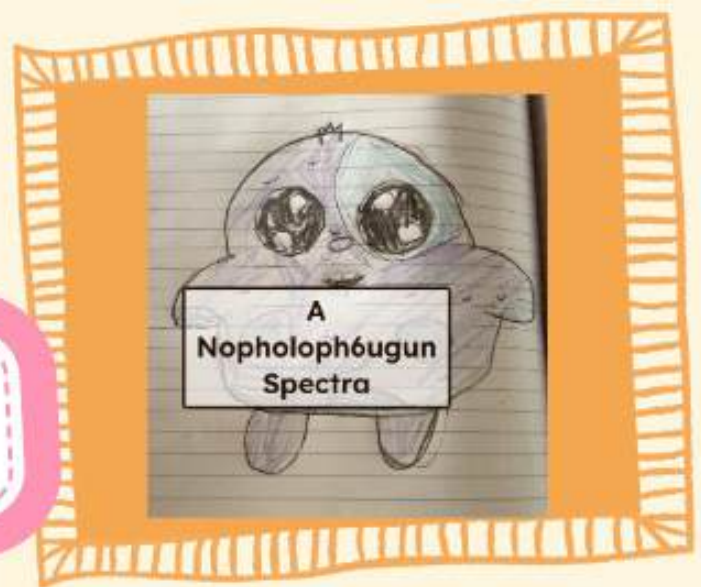

Year 3/4

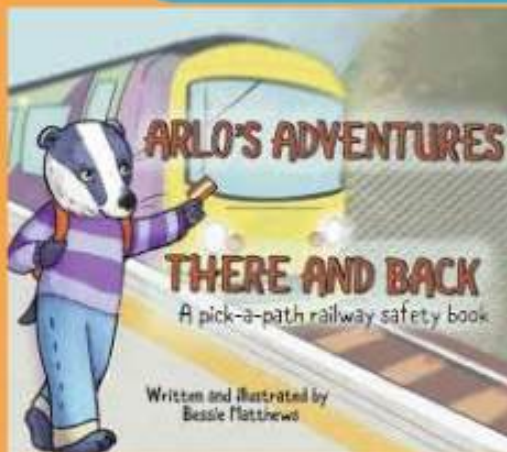


As a class we talked about what houses of the future would look like and then we came up with our own designs.
